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ANNUAL CENSUS OF ESTABLISHMENTS

The questionnaire requested information concerning total employment, and employment distribution by sex, full-time/part-time, and citizenship status.

The employment data derived from the Annual Census of Establishments (ACE) for March of each year was collected on survey forms mailed to reporting units on Guam. Extensive efforts were made to obtain a complete count of all employees. A comprehensive delinquency control system is employed which results in a very low overall non-response rates.

INDUSTRIAL CLASSIFICATION

Employment statistics in this report are classified in accordance with the Standard Industrial Classification Manual (SIC), 1987 edition, prepared by the Statistical Policy Division, Office of Management and Budget, Executive Office of the President. Prior year's ACE data were classified with the 1972 classification system so that time series constructed using both periods will not be directly comparable for some industries although the employment reclassification changes at the division level is negligible.

Reporting establishments are classified into significant economic groups by assigning a four-digit SIC code, on the basis of major products or activity as determined by the establishments' percent of total sales or receipts for the previous calendar year. All data for an establishment making more than one product or engaging in more than one activity are classified under the industry of the most important product or activity based on the percentages reported.

SURVEY QUESTIONNAIRE DEFINITIONS

EMPLOYMENT. Employed persons include both permanent and temporary employees and those who work either full-time or part-time during a specified payroll period. Workers on an establishment payroll who are paid sick leave (when pay is received directly from the employer), on paid holiday or paid vacation, or who work during only a part of the specified pay period are counted as employed. Persons on the payroll of more than one establishment during the pay period are counted in each establishment which reports them, whether the duplication is due to turnover or multiple job-holding. Persons are considered employed if they receive pay for any part of the specified pay period, but they are not considered employed if they receive no pay at all for the pay period. Since proprietor, the self-employed, and unpaid family workers do not have the status of "paid employees", they are not included. Domestic

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workers in households are also excluded. Federal Government employment statistics refer to civilian employees only.

FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME JOBS. Full-time jobs are those at which persons worked an average of 35 hours or more a week during the pay period that included the 12th day of the month, and part-time jobs are those at which persons worked an average of less than 35 hours a week during the same reference period.

CITIZENSHIP STATUS

A list of immigrant and non-immigrant alien categories obtained from the U.S. Department of Justice, Immigration and Naturalization Service, General Information publication M-50 (Rev. 2-22-89) N follows:

IMMIGRANTS:

PERMANENT RESIDENT ALIEN (PRA) - A Permanent Resident Alien is an immigrant that holds an alien registration receipt card (Form I-551 or Form I-151; commonly called a "green card").

NON-IMMIGRANTS:

A - Government Official - this classification applies to you if you are an ambassador, public minister, diplomat, or consular officer, or other official or employee assigned to represent your country to the United States. This category also applies to your immediate family, servants or attendants, and their immediate families.

B - Visitor - this classification applies to you if you have a home in a foreign country to which you will return after a short stay in the United States, and your stay is for one of the following reasons:

(1) For Business - to attend meetings, buy goods, negotiate contracts, act as a representative of a foreign employer;

(2) For Pleasure - to tour, visit friends or family, sightsee.

C - Transit - this classification applies to you if you must pass through this country on your way to a third country and will not need to stay in the United States for more than a few days. If you are a foreign representative to the United Nations and are not eligible for a "G" nonimmigrant classification, this category allows you to travel only to and from the U.N. Headquarters District.

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(1) You represent a company which will carry on trade with the United States. Your U.S. office must do 51% or more of its business (trade) with your country; or

(2) You are directing and developing a business in which you have invested a substantial amount of capital. This category also applies to your spouse and unmarried children under 21 years of age.

F - Academic Student - this classification is for you if you will be studying an academic course at a school authorized by INS to allow foreign students to attend. You must have a home in a foreign country to which you will return when you complete your studies. This classification also applies to your spouse and unmarried children under 21 years of age. **NOTE:** If you wish to study a vocational or non-academic course see "M - Non-academic Student".

G - Representative to International Organization - this classification applies to you if you are accredited by your government to represent it to an international organization such as the United Nations, World Bank, or Red Cross. This classification also applies to your spouse and unmarried children, your staff, your servants and attendants.

H - Temporary Worker - this classification applies to you if you are coming to the United States to work in a temporary job and have a home in a foreign country to which you will return after your temporary stay. There are three different classes:

(1) Alien of distinguished merit and ability -if you are a professional or otherwise of distinguished ability and the temporary job requires these unique qualities, this is the proper category for you. **NOTE:** If you are a graduate of a foreign medical school you may be classified H-1 only if you are coming to teach or conduct research at a public or non-profit institution.

(2) Temporary Services for general labor - if you have a skill which is in short supply in the United States and the job you will fill is only a temporary one, this is the proper category for you. **NOTE:** If you are a graduate of a foreign medical school you may not be classified as an H-2.

(3) Trainee - If you will receive training which is not available in your home country and which you will use outside of the United States, this is the proper category for you. Additionally, the person providing your training must have an established, formal program to provide the training. **NOTE:** If you are a graduate of a medical school you may not be classified as an H-3.

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(4) Dependents 0 Your spouse and unmarried children under 12 years of age may be classified as H-4's, if you are classified H-1, H-2, or H-3. (See "Special Requirements - H Petitions").

I - Foreign Information Media Representative - this classification is for you if you will represent a foreign newspaper, radio station, television station, news service, etc., in the United States. The classification would include your spouse and unmarried children under 21 years of age.

J - Exchange Alien - this classification applies to you if you will participate in a program approved by the United States Information Agency. Your program participation can be as a student, scholar, trainee, teacher, professor, research assistant, specialist, or leader in a field of specialized knowledge. If you are a graduate of a foreign medical school and you wish to receive graduate medical education or training in the United States you must meet special requirements. These requirements can be explained to you by a consular official, an immigration official or by contacting the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates. The ECFMG is located at 3624 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19104.

To further qualify as an exchange alien you must have a home in a foreign country to which you will return after your stay in the United States. This classification applies to your spouse and unmarried children under 21 years of age.

K - Fiance or Fiancee - this classification is for you if you are planning to marry a citizen of the United States

K - Fiance or Fiancee - this classification is for you if you are planning to marry a citizen of the United States. Your marriage to the petitioner must take place within 90 days of your arrival in this country. Your unmarried children under 21 years of age would also qualify for this classification. (See "Special Requirements - K Petitions".)

L - Intra-Company Transferee - this classification applies to you if you are coming to the United States to work for the parent company, branch, subsidiary or affiliate of your foreign employer. You must have been employed by the foreign company for at least one year immediately prior to your transfer to this country. Also, your employment must have been as an executive, manager, or specialist and the job in the United States must be in one of those categories. This classification can also include your spouse and unmarried children under 21 years of age. (See "Special Requirements - L Petitions".)

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M - this classification applies to you if you will be studying at a vocational or other non-academic school which has been authorized by INS to allow foreign students to attend. You must have a home in a foreign country to which you will return after you complete your studies. Your spouse and unmarried children under 21 years of age can also be included in this classification.

N - this classification applies to you if you are a parent or child of a person special immigrant permanent resident status as an officer, employee or a family member of an officer or employee of an international organization who was admitted to the United States as a G-IV nonimmigrant.

OTHERS - Most of the employees classified in the "other" category are those aliens authorized to work in the United States by the Compact of Free Association Act (P.L. 99-239).

The following information is furnished by the Immigration and Naturalization Service in an effort to clarify the authorization of certain aliens in the United States to accept employment.

Paragraph 212 of Title 8 Code of Federal Regulations, provides that the following classes of person, ".....may enter into, lawfully engage in employment, and establish residence in the United States and its territories and possessions without regard to paragraphs (14), (20) and (26) of Section 212 (a) of the Act pursuant to the terms of Public Law 99-239." (Paragraphs (14), (20) and (26) of Section 212(a) relate to the requirements for labor certification, visa, and passport:)

- (1) a person who, on the day preceding the effective date of this Compact, is a citizen of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, as defined in Title 53 of the Trust Territory Code in force on January 1, 1979, and has become a citizen of the Marshall Islands or the Federated States of Micronesia;
- (2) a person who acquires the citizenship of the Marshall Islands or the Federated States of Micronesia at birth, on or after the effective date of the respective Constitution;
- (3) a naturalized citizen of the Marshall Islands or of the Federated States of Micronesia who has been an actual resident there for not less than five years after attaining such naturalization and who holds a certificate of actual residence; or

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(4) a person entitled to citizenship in the Marshal Islands by lineal descent whose name is included in a list to be furnished by the Government of the Marshal Islands to the United States Immigration and naturalization Service and any descendants of such persons, provided that such person holds a certificate of lineal descent issued by the Government of the Marshal Islands.'

Such residence in the United States does not, however, satisfy the residence requirements for the purpose of naturalization, nor to petition for benefits for alien relatives under the Act.
